## BRAND STANDARDS MANUAL

## INTRODUCTION

The following is a guide for the proper usage of the Onsted Community Schools brand identity. All Onsted staff, students, coaches, and vendors should refer to the manual when creating communications that represent Onsted and the district. This includes official apparel, documents, digital media, products, etc.

The intention is to put forth a strong, unified image of the district, reflecting a commitment to quality and consistency.

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The district logo should be used in its one color version on white and light colored backgrounds, in either gold or purple. The black logo can be used when there is not an option to use a color version.

For use on dark backgrounds there are two-color versions in both gold and purple. The solid gold logo can also be used on dark backgrounds.

Preferably the logo should used as a whole, but when necessary the ' $O$ ' and text elements can be used separately.

The horizontal layout of the district logo is to be used when best suited for the space available, particularly for

## ACADEMIC EMBLEM

The academic emblem is a secondary logotype that is an option available to all three buildings - K-12. The use of the emblem should only be used in reference to academics

The emblem should be used in its one color version on white

ON DARK BACKGROUND and light colored backgrounds, in either gold or purple. The black logo can be used when there is not an option to use a color version.

For use on dark backgrounds there are two-color versions in both gold and purple. The solid gold logo can also be used on dark backgrounds.

## ATHLETIC LOGOS

The Athletic O and Wildcat, can be utilized together or as separate elements. Files are available for all of the acceptable uses:

ONSTED WILDCATS as well as any team name can be added underneath any version of the the athletic marks using OSWALD (see typography).

While a stricter adherence to these standards for uniforms and official gear is needed team spiritwear can incoporate outside graphic elements that are sport specific as well as other fonts. However, when using either an O , Wildcat, or paw in those designs they must be from the official set of logos.
